CHAMPAGNE AND SPARKLING WINE

301 House Champagne £37.50

Chosen from the hundreds of producers in France's Champagne district to provide a typical example of this famous wine at the best possible price.

302 Veuve Valmante Brut £18.00

French sparkling wine, light, elegant, refreshing.

303 Veuve Clicquot Vintage £60.00

Rich, biscuity nose. More mellow than the NV, with more honeyed lemony fruit. A very fine mousse helps to wash the delicious flavours across the palate. A rich delicate style.

WHITE WINE

304 South African Rocheburg Chenin Blanc £15.00 *Manager's Recommendation*

Attractive deep straw colour, with green tints. Tropical fruits on the nose, pineapple, peaches and apples. Fresh, lively palate - creamy texture and fruit, balanced by good green acidity.

305 German Bernkasteler Kurfurtslay Kabinett QmP - Schmitt Sohne £15.50

A generosity of ripeness, finesse, lively acidity and a honeyed depth from this Mosel wine. Kabinett denotes the lightest and most delicate of German wine.

306 Italian San Antonio Pinot Grigio £18.00

The Garganega contributes floral notes and lifts Italy's famous Pinot Grigio to create a crisp, aromatic and wonderfully complex wine. Light straw with green tints in colour, it has fruity, flowery bouquet. Surprisingly full-bodied with an excellent structure.

307 Chilean Villa Rosa Sauvignon Blanc £16.50

Vigorous, vibrant, dry white wine that will lift the duldest of palates.

308 Marques de Caceres Blanco £20.00

A rich, nutty, full-bodied wine with a distinctive flavour of baked apples and pears, and a pale golden colour.

309 Australian Brown Brothers Everton £20.00

Sassy, unwooded, dry white. Delicate aromas of peach, apricot and almonds. On the palate - fresh, crisp and lively with attractive fruit flavours.

ROSÉ WINE

310 South East Australian Castle Creek Petit Verdot £15.00

Deep coloured Aussie rosé, with richly fruity blackberry and raspberry flavours.

RED WINE

311 Italian Lascari Nero d'Avola £15.00 *Manager's Recommendation*

A very characterful fruit-driven red, which is soft, approachable and easy to drink. A great pasta wine, but also ideal on its own.

313 French Carignan 'Vieilles Vignes' Vin de Pays d'Oc Domaine Carnaval £19.00

A spicy wine with ripe black fruit flavours and warm herbal notes. Fleshy texture, with ripe tannins and a touch of oak spice on the finish. Long and complex.

314 French Côtes du Rhône AC - Alexis Boisselet £16.00

Wine from around the Châteauneuf du Pape area: unusually Syrah or Shiraz with its intense sweetness which fades to a spicy pepperiness dominates the grape blend, giving an easy drinking but warming red wine.

315 South African Rocheburg Western Cape Pinotage £17.00

The Pinotage, being a cross of the Pinot Noir and the Cinsault grape varieties, carries the intense fruit of the former and the weight and power of the latter.

316 Cumbres Andinas Malbec £19.50

A wine with natural exuberance. Lovely, deep red colour with a fruity nose, along with toasted elements of vanilla and chocolate on the palate.

317 South East Australian Castle Creek Cabernet Sauvignon £17.00

Concentrated plum and blackcurrant aromas. Berry fruit flavours persist on the palate with the firm tannin backbone providing a well-structured palate. The oak maturation has added some spice and coffee characters.

318 Australian Brown Brothers Everton £20.00

Full-bodied, full flavoured red blend from one of Australia's most innovative wine-makers. Ripe red berry fruit, violets, subtle oak and a slightly gamey character.

320 Spanish Valserrano Crianza £22.50

Very attractive nose of warm strawberries. A soft, light-medium weight palate with strawberry fruit flavours and savoury overtones of leather and oak.
