

Guidance for the Driving Range



Opening Times

In general, the driving range will be open from dawn to dusk. The Club will publish on the Range Booking System a schedule of precise opening times as required. The Trackman system will not be available from 22:00 to 06:00 on any day.

Indoor/Outdoor

The range will operate as Indoor only or Outdoor only at any given time and all bays are numbered.

Booking System

All bays can be booked in advance using the booking system on the Club website (www.mangc.co.uk). Members are permitted to use the range without booking in advance but must check the booking system to ensure the bay they are using is free. Members using the range without a booking must vacate any pre-booked bays on the request of members with a booking.

If the weather dictates that the outdoor bays cannot be used, then the indoor bays will become available on a first come first served basis.

On completing a session Members are required to depart from the driving range as promptly as possible.

- Bay 1 is recommended for iron use only.
- Bay 7 is recommended for left-handed players.

Ball Hire

The driving range is only available to members using hired range balls. Members cannot use personal golf balls on the range. Range balls are dispensed at the range from the automated ball dispenser.

Each member is issued with a Range Card to be used to pay for ball hire. The Range Card is an intelligent swipe card holding relevant member details. Use of the Range Card provides a discount on ball hire costs to members.

Members can pay at the bar for credits to be added to their Range Card which will operate the ball dispenser. One credit will dispense twenty-five balls. Unused Credits on Range Cards remain valid for as long as members hold a category of membership that includes Range Access (for example all playing membership categories).

The ball dispenser will take Debit/Credit card payments for ball hire, but Members will not receive a discount for such payments.

No balls may be taken away from the range at any time.

Use of Trackman

The use of Trackman is not compulsory, but Trackman is available to all users. Information on how to use Trackman is available on the website.

When operating Indoor, dedicated Trackman screens are available in each bay.

When operating Outdoor, Trackman can be accessed via the Trackman App on a personal smart phone, tablet, or laptop. The Trackman App is free to download via the QR code below:

Dress Code

Golfing attire must be worn on the Range and the Short Game area at all times.

Visitors

The range is only available to members and visitors who have paid a green fee. Visitors wishing to use the range are required to book a bay via the office or Pro Shop.

Parking

Parking is available adjacent to the driving range. Designated parking spaces must be used and parking is not permitted on the road. All vehicles are parked at the owner's risk.

Access to the Driving Range

The driving range must be accessed via the right-hand door opening adjacent to the ball dispenser. Members must use the ramp from the car park onto the footpath and the ramp from the footpath into the covered bays. Members must not access the range via the door opening leading to the Teaching Studio.

Greens Staff

Greens staff working on the range have priority at all times.

Members using the facility should wait for staff to move out of range.

Members must be courteous to Greens staff at all times.

Ball Collection Staff

Ball collection staff working on the range have priority at all times.

Members must be courteous to Ball Collection staff at all times.

Health and Safety

All Members use the driving range entirely at their own risk.

All Members have a duty of care to themselves and others to use the facility in a safe manner.

When operating Indoor all players must hit balls from a designated bay using the dedicated mat and must not enter the grassed area to hit or retrieve balls.

When operating Outdoor all players must hit balls from a designated grass bay within the bay markers.

When swinging clubs or hitting balls please take account of the surrounding people, furniture, and fixtures.

No smoking is allowed on the range.

No consumption of alcohol is allowed on the range.

First Aid

Assistance is available within the Clubhouse, the Pro's Shop, and from the Greens staff.

All accidents/incidents must be reported to the Office on 0161 643 3202.

Emergencies
